We have been receiving a little more email this week from parents anxious to know when we will announce our decision. In the spirit of open communication and transparency, here's an update you.

Last week, just after we sent our most recent email to you, the state of Michigan finally added representatives from day- and overnight camps to its advisory board on child care. We happen to be in close contact with two of those camp professionals. The group has spent the week in talks with the governor's office about how to safely open camps. (Yes, there are CDC and American Camp Association guidelines, but states have the final word.) The state's protocols/regulations would be handed down to our licensing agency (LARA), and we would use those parameters in our decision-making process.

Later today we expect to receive an update from those advisory board representatives about where things stand. We have been told to expect something (!?!) from the state by mid-next week.

Again, thank you for hanging in there with us. We know lots of camps have announced decisions in the past week. Michigan is just a little further behind in the process.
